

TITLES OF JESUS TREE ORNAMENTS

Instructions

You will need:

Titles of Jesus tabs and ornaments pattern printed on 1 sheet 8-1/2x11 white card stock

2 sheets 8-1/2x11 colored card stock

24 feet (288 inches) of 3/16" or 1/4" white curling ribbon

OR 12 metal ornament hooks

Gold or silver glitter

Pencil

Sharp scissors

Paper punch

Glue stick

White liquid glue

Flat toothpicks

Ruler or yardstick (if making ribbon ornament hangers)

Instructions:

1. Cut out the Title of Jesus tabs and the ornament pattern.
2. Trace the ornament pattern 12 times on the colored card stock and cut them out.
3. Punch holes close to the tops of the ornaments.
4. Use a glue stick to glue the title tabs onto the ornaments, centering carefully.
5. Make a little puddle of liquid white glue on a piece of paper. Use the large end of a flat toothpick to apply liquid glue halfway around the edges of a title tab. Sprinkle glitter on the glue and shake off the excess. Do the same process for the other half of the tab edge. Then do the same for the rest of the ornaments. It may take 24 hours for the glue to cure.
6. If you wish to hang the ornaments with ribbon, rather than metal hooks, wait until the glue and glitter are well cured. Then attach the ribbon hangers as follows:
 - a. Cut twelve 24-inch pieces of the curling ribbon.
 - b. Thread one end of one of the ribbons through the hole in one of the ornaments.
 - c. With the ends even, tie a knot just above the hole.
 - d. With the two strands together as a single strand, tie a knot and pull it tight about two inches from the top of the ornament.
 - e. Tie the loose ends into a bow.
 - f. Do the same for all the other ornaments.
 - g. Trim any bow tails that are too long or uneven.
